## A proven process...

The 2013 version of this process yielded a Citizen Advisory Team recommendation to City Council that put four individual categories of projects on the November 2013 ballot.

### Fire Stations

\$6.5 million

Expansion and new construction



### Library

\$2.5 million

Expansion and renovation



### Parks

\$7.2 million

Acquisition and improvements



### Streets

\$7.7 million

Improvements



Voters approved all four.
