

CHILD SUPPORT AFFIDAVIT

“Under Texas Family Code, Section 231.006 a sole proprietorship, corporation or other entity in which a sole proprietor, partner, majority shareholder of a corporation or an owner of ten percent (10%) or more of an other business entity is thirty (30) days or more delinquent in paying child support under a court order or written repayment agreement is not eligible to bid on or receive a state contract.”

To comply with Section 231.006, the affidavit below shall be signed by the person who is authorized to sign and submit a bid, and thereby bind the Bidder, and must be returned with the Bid. A failure to do so will result in the disqualification of the Bid.
